41	8:35 am	Old Lake Junaluska Warriors Field	This will be for Hyder Mountain Road and Thickety beyond Thompson Cove
10	8:35 am	Hot Spot on Asheville Highway	This will be for Asheville Hwy beyond the Hotspot, Chestnut Mountain Road and Groundhog Road
32	8:15am	Cruso United Methodist Church	This stop will be for the Upper Cruso Community. There will be no stops on side roads.
168	8:40am	Lake Logan Fire Department	Edwards Cove to Lake Logan Rd This stop will be for all of Upper Lake Logan Community including Little East Fork.
	9:10 am	Frank's Grocery	This stop will be for the Lower Cruso Community. There will be no stops on side roads.
8	8:45 am	Intersection of Willis Cove Rd and Worley Cove Rd (where the bridge is out at)	This stop is for any student up Willis Cove or Worley Cove Rd beyond the bridge that is out at.
