

aywood County School System is the largest school system west of Buncombe County. It is comprised of 9 elementary schools, three middle schools, and three high schools.

The total enrollment for the system is 7,662. Tuscola has over 1,000 students enrolled. Tuscola is located in the Great Smokey Mountains, about 25 miles west of Asheville, NC.

Tuscola High school has a traditional 7 period day schedule. Classes meet for 50 minutes and credits are awarded at the end of the academic year. Tuscola is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

Athletic teams compete in the 3A Mountain Athletic Conference. Numerous athletic opportunities are available to students.
