## Scholarship Information – January 8, 2014

- The Community Foundation of Western North Carolina Scholarships There are several scholarships available to Tuscola High School students, including Nathaniel Ellis Cannady, Jr., Harry W. Clarke (2year and 4year schools), Chuck D. Hargrove (Tuscola High School only), Captain John G. Gardner, and the WNC Regional Scholarships. - WCU Scholarships Several scholarships at WCU now require a separate scholarship application. Students must have submitted the application for admission and have received their WCU student identification number in order to apply. The application can be completed online at <a href="https://www.scholarcat.wcu.edu">www.scholarcat.wcu.edu</a> and the deadline is February 1, 2014.
- North Carolina Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarship Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and must be turned back into the Counseling Center by Monday February 3, 2014, so that we may turn in to the local chapter. There are 3 different scholarships available and different criteria for each!
- Scotty Cochran Scholarship Students whose family is a member of Haywood County Farm Bureau will have priority but others are encouraged to apply! Students must be a resident of Haywood County and plan on attending a technical/community, junior college, or four-year institution. Students must have a 2.5 GPA, provide evidence of financial need, and have significant community service. Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and applications must be returned to Haywood County Farm Bureau by March 15, 2014.
