



DECEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

(Please check with colleges regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met!
This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.)

Check out the school you are interested in on their website for additional scholarships!

- \$ **NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- \$ **Air Force ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The criteria includes SAT score of 1180 (Math & Critical reading only), ACT Composite of 26, and a GPA of 3.0.
- \$ **Berea College Scholarships**—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor!!!
- \$ **Lenoir-Rhyne University Teaching Scholars**— Can provide up to \$5,500 per year for four years. Learn more about this program and apply at EDU.LR.EDU/TEACHINGSCHOLARS.
- \$ **Meredith College**—Download talent scholarship applications at Meredith.edu/admissions deadline is January 15th.
- \$ Students that are interested in a Trade School such as **Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Marine Mechanics Institute, and Motorcycle Mechanics Institute** may visit UTI.edu/scholarships
- \$ **CFWNC Scholarships**— These scholarships and their materials are now on the CFWNC website. There are several scholarships available including Chuck D. Hargrove Scholarship (**THS students only**), Nathaniel Ellis Cannady, Jr. Scholarship, WNC Regional Scholarships, and several more. This is one application that you complete to be eligible for several scholarships.
- \$ **BK Scholars**—Win a \$50,000, \$25,000, \$5,000, or \$1,000 scholarship. High school seniors, Burger King employees, and children of Burger King employees are eligible to apply. Visit <https://www.scholarshipamerica.org/burgerkingscholars/information.php>. Applications are due by **December 15, 2014**.
- \$ **Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships**—Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and are due back to the Counseling Center on **January 15, 2015** so that we can turn in applications to local chapter. There are 3 separate scholarships you may apply for!
- \$ **Western Carolina University Scholarships**—The online scholarship application is available at scholarcat.wcu.edu and the deadline to apply is **February 1, 2015**. Students do not have to wait for acceptance to apply but they will not be eligible for consideration if acceptance is not finalized by the deadline. Students must also complete the FAFSA by March 1, 2015.
- \$ **Ione M. Allen Music Scholarship**—Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement and financial need, demonstrate traits of high personal character and leadership, demonstrate a musical aptitude, and must major in Music and be planning to attend a musical conservatory or other educational institution. Semi-Finalist will be interviewed by the Awards Advisory Committee, and will present a 5-minute musical performance. Deadline is **January 21, 2015**. Apply on-line at www.csascholars.org.

- \$ **Montreat College**—WNC Scholarship Program at Montreat provides eligible students in Haywood County an opportunity to apply. Students must have a 3.0 GPA and 1000 combined Critical Reading and Math score on SAT or 21 Composite ACT score. Apply for Admission by **January 1, 2015**. - \$ **Roanoke College Scholars Program**—To apply, students must visit www.roanoke.edu/scholars by **January 5th** for the February Competition.
- \$ **Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships**—
The only eligibility requirements are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need. - \$ **Ronald McDonald House Charities Scholarship Program**—There are four different scholarships to apply for so please review information to see which scholarships you may be eligible for at <https://aim.applyists.net/RMHC>. We have had a Tuscola student win in the past so please apply! The application deadline is **January 20, 2015**.
- \$ **University of Dayton Leadership in Service Scholarship**—THS can nominate one student to participate in the program. If you are interested—please see your counselor by January 9, 2015 so that we can discuss the scholarship application. More information is available in the Counseling Center.
- \$ **NCAE Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. You must be able to explain how the philosophies and ideals of Dr. King influence your life. The application and supporting materials must be postmarked by **February 2, 2015**.
