- \$ Sigma Phi Epsilon Balanced Man Scholarship Two scholarships of \$1000 and \$500 are rewarded to male students who strive to achieve balance in addition to all around excellence in their lives. If interested you may pick up an application in the counseling center. Applicants must have applied to and plan on attending East Tennessee State University in the Fall of 2013. The deadline for applications is May 23, 2013. Students must also send their updated high school transcripts.
