- **\$ ETSU Scholarships**—Eligibility requirements and more scholarship information is available at http://www.etsu.edu/scholarships/. Complete application for admission must be received by December 15, 2012.
- \$ Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships—Information is available at <u>http://www.mensafoundation.org/scholarships</u>. All entries must be postmarked by January 15, 2013. Awards will be made on the basis of an essay of fewer than 550 words, which describes the applicant's career, vocational, or academic goal. Awards are made in amounts of \$300 to \$1000.
