- Southwestern Community College Scholarships—Applications are available at <u>www.southwesterncc.edu/content/scholarships-scc-students</u>. Application deadlines vary.
- \$ Jagannathan Scholarship—You must apply for this scholarship by logging on to your CFNC account through <u>www.cfnc.org/jag</u>. A CSS Profile must accompany the application which must be submitted by February 15, 2013.
- \$ Nathaniel Ellis Cannady, JR. Scholarship— For students planning on studying engineering, construction, project management or information technology. Applications are available in the counseling center and are due on February 13th, 2013
- \$ 2012 Student-View Scholarship Program—Simply log on to <u>www.student-view.com</u> and complete a 15-20 application survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship will be awarded via a random drawing of all completed applications. The deadline is April 22, 2013.
- **\$ The Carrols LLC Community Scholarship Fund**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. Applications must be completed and returned by **April 1, 2013**. Winners are chosen on merit basis and completion of application, including attached transcripts and recommendations.
