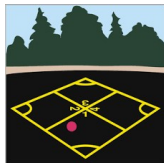

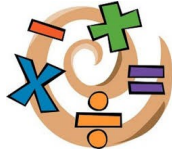


Anime Club For artists and illustrators of any level. Come draw with us! Sponsor: Ms. Kea

Chess Club for players of every level! We meet in the media center. Sponsor: Ms. Wantz



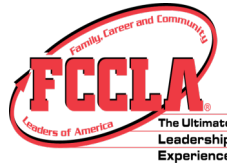
