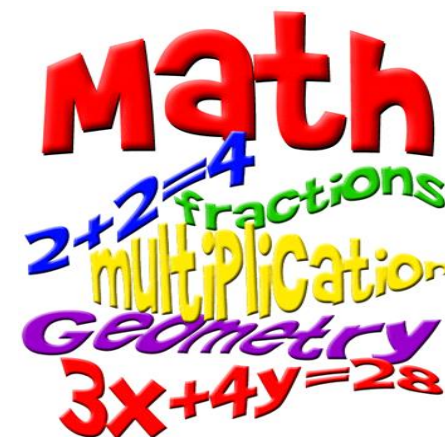

ABSENCE/TARDIES

Attendance will be taken daily: Students must be in class and on time for the entire duration of class, PARTICIPATE, and attempt all assignments in order to be successful. The school attendance policy will be followed.

- Absences 7-9 Make Up Time Required
