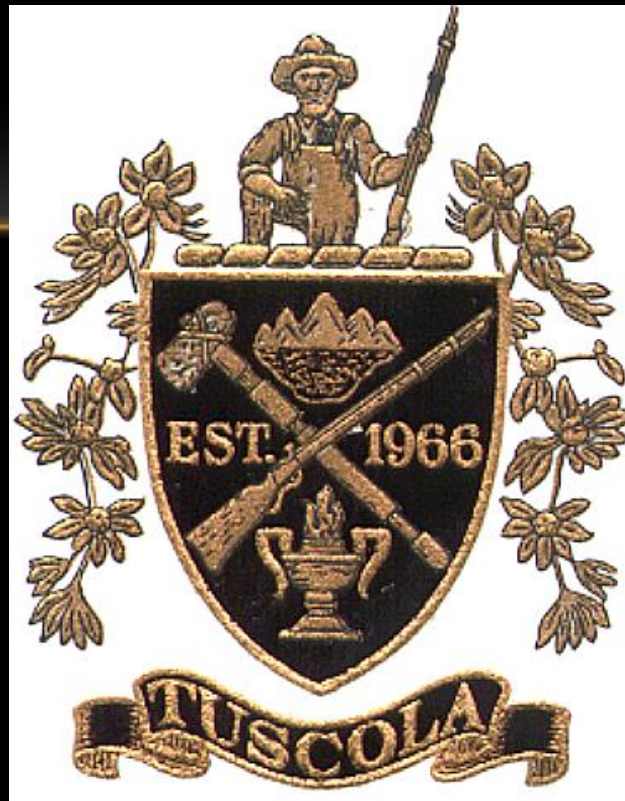

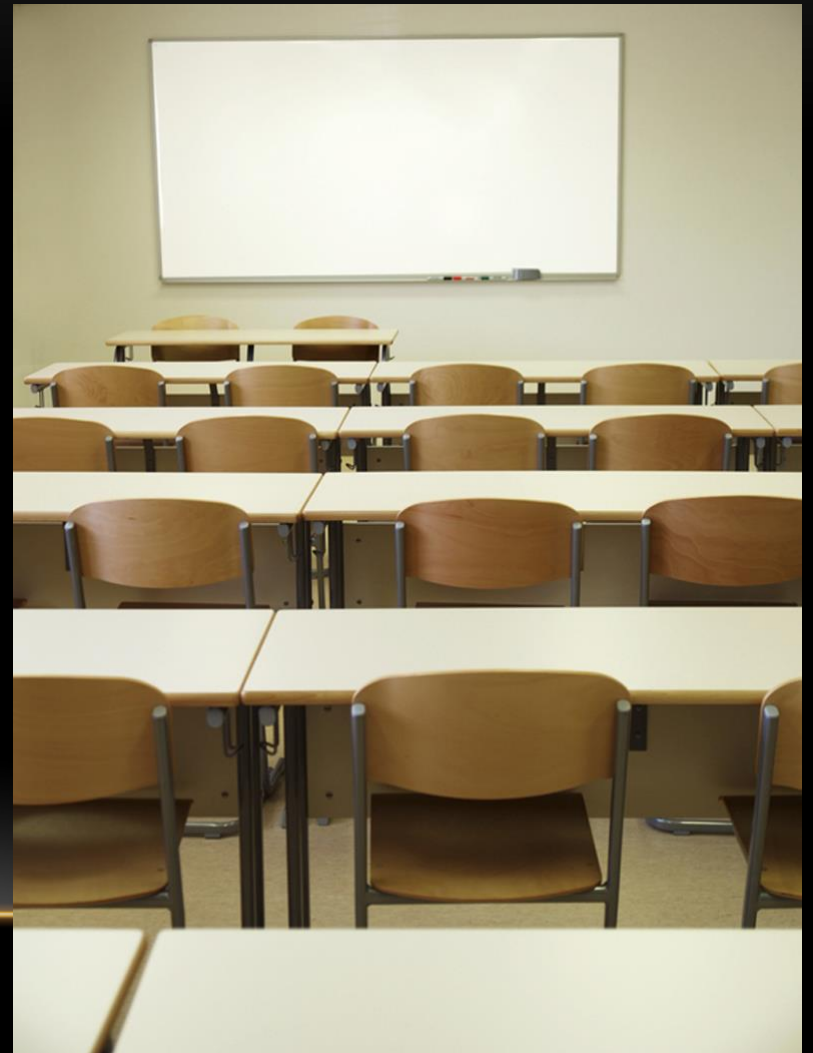
What To Consider:

 - Demonstrated Interest



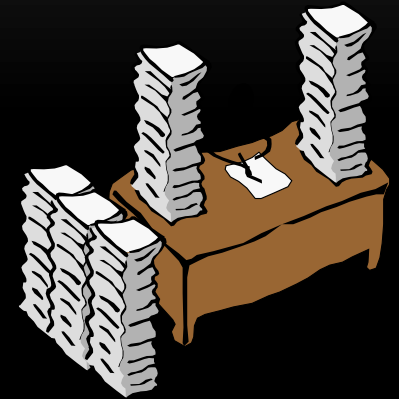
Get To Know A School From The Inside

- Take a campus tour.
- Speak with an admissions counselor.
- Ask about financial aid opportunities.
- Sit in on a class of interest.
- Read the student newspaper.
- Talk to students and faculty.



GET ORGANIZED AND APPLY

- Narrow and categorize your choices
 - “More than likely” schools (1 or 2)
 - “Good match” schools (2 to 4)
 - “Reach” schools (1 or 2)
- Review scholarship and financial aid requirements.
- Revise application essays and share drafts with a trusted teacher, adviser or family member.
- Ask for recommendations and set firm dates for their completion.
- Request transcripts and schedule mock interviews, if needed.
