

## **Career & College Promise @ Haywood Community College**

- 1. Meet with your high school counselor to determine eligibility for the Dual Enrollment program.** (You must meet the criteria established by your high school and Haywood Community College prior to applying for the dual enrollment program at HCC).
- 2. Read the CCP Parent/Student Manual located on HCC's website located under the High School Programs tab.**
- 3. Meet with Jessica Honeycutt, High School Programs Coordinator to discuss college courses and expectation.** (See your high school counselor to see when she will be on your high school campus or contact her at: [jhoneycutt@haywod.edu](mailto:jhoneycutt@haywod.edu) or by phone: 828-565-4119)
- 4. Submit your completed application for admission application along with the Career & College Promise Parent Permission Form, and the FERPA form to your High School Counselor and he/she will give it to Jessica Honeycutt, High School Programs Coordinator.**

**What to expect.** An advising and registration appointment is a structure conversation between you and your advisor. You can prepare ahead of time for your appointment, by reviewing the upcoming class schedule.

**What are your goals and degree plans?** It is helpful for your advisor to know if you have academic/career goals or if you have yet to determine your goals. If you are undecided about a career, we can schedule appointments for career planning sessions.

**Review general education or major requirements.** If you are planning to transfer to a four-year college/university, then check out our Associate in Arts program. These courses are the freshman and sophomore courses taught at the four-year college. These courses have also been approved to satisfy the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement general education core requirement.
