

Tuscola High School Needs Your Help!

Many families have asked for tangible ways that they can help Tuscola High School. Volunteering to proctor during our end of the year assessments is a fantastic way to support our students, our faculty, and our community!

During North Carolina End of Course Testing, THS is in need of volunteers to help “proctor” in testing rooms. The State requires testing to occur the last five-days of school (currently Jan 8-12th). The role of a proctor is to serve as an additional monitor who helps the test administrator ensure that testing occurs fairly and uniformly. The main responsibilities of a proctor involve making sure that the room conditions are appropriate and providing an additional level of supervision. We ask that proctors attend one mandatory training session before testing. Training will last approximately 30-minutes. You can choose one of the following times for training: Tuesday, December 12 at 1:00 OR Thursday, December 14th at 9:00 OR Monday, December 18th at 10:00. All trainings will occur in the THS media center.
