

ABSENCE/MAKEUP WORK

- Assignments due on a day when a student is absent will be accepted without penalty the first day the student is back in class.

- ✓ Absences are the #1 reason for low grades.

GRADING

Tests – 50% Quizzes – 30% Assignments/Classwork - 20%

RETAKES & LATEWORK

- Late assignments will be accepted up to the end of the unit for 70% earned credit
- Retakes will be given on an assessment if remediation is completed at least 24 hrs before retakes are scheduled.

Assign \rightarrow Quiz \rightarrow Test

Assignments are learning activities where mistakes are errors are made. Quizzes are the individual assessments - perfection is not expected so quizzes may be redone by appointment. Tests are the Grand Finale, mastery is expected. Retakes are available after remediation is completed.

CELL PHONE POLICY
