TEST CORRECTIONS POLICY

You have the opportunity to complete Test Corrections on <u>4 of the 7 tests</u> we take this year.

- To earn back 50% of the points you lost, you must rework each missed question on a blank sheet of paper. After you find the correct answer you must explain (*in complete sentences*) what you did incorrectly the first time, and how you corrected your mistake.
- You may use your notes to help you complete the test corrections.
- If you are struggling to identify where you made your errors, or are stuck on specific problems, you can schedule a meeting with me during my office hours to receive some feedback to point you in the right direction.

T S PROCEDURES
