

Expectations

1. Do your best, every day, every exercise. Make excellent effort a habit and excellent results follow.
2. Do your work. No internet answers.
3. Be prepared for class: Chromebook charged, have your English notebook and folder. Have a writing instrument.
4. You may sit wherever and with whomever you choose, until the arrangement becomes a distraction.
5. Telephones are to be placed in your named slot up front. One point will be earned every day the device is holstered up front under a grade for "Cooperation and Follows Directions." We have approximately 90 class days so these points will add up.

If you choose not to cooperate or follow directions and your device is wrongfully used during class, you will be asked to put it in the phone holder for the duration of class and you will be given a written assignment. Every subsequent offence will result in a referral to the office for ISS.
