Conduct & Discipline Policy

Late Work Policy

You will generally only have homework if we do not finish an assignment in class. Homework assignments are announced in class, posted on the board, and posted on Google Classroom. They are always due the day after they are assigned (unless otherwise indicated) and should be turned in at the very beginning of class or they are considered late. A one-time deduction of 10 points will be taken on late assignments. If absent, assignments are not considered late according to the county attendance policy. Missing assignments will not be accepted after the unit test. Students and parents can track missing work on Infinite Campus. Exceptions can be made if students talk to me about unusual circumstances that prevented completing work on time.

Attendance & Tardies

We will follow the school attendance policy. If you miss class, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed.

Missing over 15 minutes of class will result in an absence. On the third tardy, you will receive one day of detention. Continued tardiness will lead to a conference with a parent or administrator.

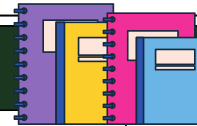


Entering Class



- If the classroom door is closed, please wait in the hall until I open it.

- Be in your seat working on the given task when the bell rings.

Hall Pass



- Use the restroom between classes.
- No more than two people will be allowed out of the room at a time.
- Use the online Hall Pass system to go to the bathroom.
- If the online Hall Pass system says you have to wait in the line, then you must wait until it says you can go.

Important Note

- Students are considered tardy if they enter the classroom without a pass after the bell has rung.
